10 – 12'

Large constrictor snake. Tan body with dark blotches that do not touch; distinctive dark and light wedges beneath eyes.

5 – 9"

Yellowish-tan to dark brown; red dewlap with yellow border.

1.5 – 3"

Body color is *highly* variable and may be marked with irregular dark stripes or blotches. Skin is warty and eyes reddish.

7 – 10.5"

Ranges from gray to tan with a curled tail.

10 – 12"

The face and limbs are green with numerous yellow stripes, and a broad red stripe is present in the "ear" region. As they age, their color and pattern dulls.

2 – 3"

Large carnivorous lizard. Dark bands with plentiful white dots between them.
